


Crafting with Mia: Making a Blossom

- 1. Cut construction paper into thin strips, about half an inch think. You will need four strips for each flower you make.
- 2. Start your blossom by putting a dot of glue at the center of a cut strip.
- 3. Lay a second strip on top, perpendicular to the first one.
- 4. Add another dot of glue to the center and lay a third strip with the edges inbetween the first two. Repeat with the fourth strip.
- 5. Fold each strip to the center of the flower, securing it with another drop of glue. Do this 8 times untill all your strips have been folded into petals.
- 6. Using a second color of paper, cut out a circle the size of a quarter and glue it to the center of the petals.
- 7. Repeat these steps to make more flowers and then decorate with them however you want!

You will need:

- colored construction paper
- scissors
- tape or glue
